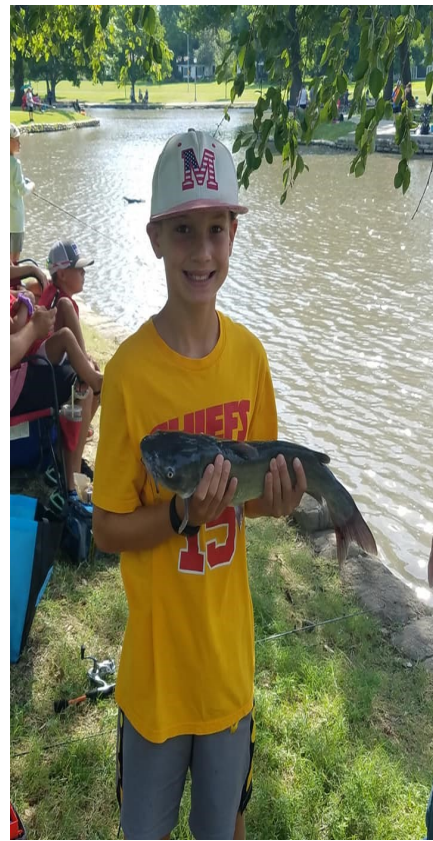

WALK-ON FIELDS Homeside ~ Rolf ~ County ~ Wall ~ Grant Soccer/Football Fields & Baseball/Softball Fields A ,B, D & T-Ball

These fields are available for walk-on use unless closed due to maintenance, marked for a game or too wet for play. Reservations take precedence over walk-ons. MRC teams can reserve 7 days in advance, all others 2 days in advance. Youth teams may reserve two hours per week & adult teams may reserve one hour per week. The week runs Sunday - Saturday. Call 241-0363 or stop by 220 N. Walnut to make a reservation. Light usage is \$10 per hour. You must make arrangements Monday - Friday by 5 pm and pay for light usage at the MRC Office.

LIMITED ACCESS FACILITY Grant Complex - Baseball Field C

This field is designated as a Limited Access Facility, which means access is strictly controlled by MRC. You must have MRC's approval to use this facility. This facility is marked "No unauthorized practices allowed."

 Grant Restrooms are open from 7 am - Dusk, except December-February.

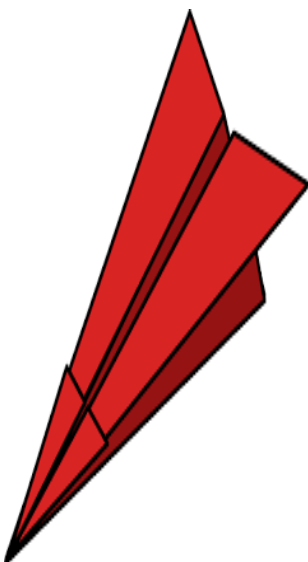
MRC Guidelines

Financial aid applications are available at the MRC Office, 220 N. Walnut St. or online at www.mcphersonrecreationcommission.org for non-sport activities.

MRC REFUND POLICY: It is the policy of the McPherson Recreation Commission to refund 80% of the unused portion of the program fee due to medical reasons or moving from McPherson County.

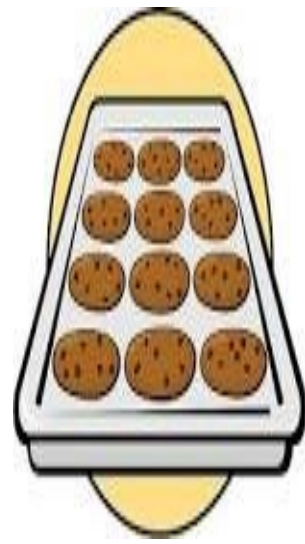
